Tractor Operator s - \$18.02 per hr.

Responsibilities:

- Able to drive gasoline or diesel powered tractor to move materials draw implements, tow trailers;
- Experienced in steering tractor by turning steering wheel and depressing brake pedals'
- Release brake, shift gears and depress accelerator or move throttle to control forward and backward movement of tractor;
- Ability to pull out objects embedded in ground;
- Pull cable of winch to raise, lower or load heavy material or equipment.
- Responsibility to fasten attachments such as graders, plows, rollers, mowers (over 2000 lbs)
- Backhoes, seeders and disc harrows to tractor;

- Load and unload trucks and other conveyances;
- cleaning and preparing a job site
- Move supplies and materials to proper location by wheelbarrows or hand trucks;
- Stack material for storage or binning;
- Collect refuse and salvageable materials;
- Dig, fill and tamp earth excavations;
- Level ground using pick, shovel, tamper and rake;
- Shovel concrete and snow;
- Clean culverts and ditches;
- Cut trees and brush;
- Operate power lawnmowers;
- Move and arrange heavy pieces of office and household furniture; equipment and appliances;
- Move heavy pieces of automotive, medical engineering and other types of machinery and equipment;
- Spread sand and salt on icy roads and walk-ways;
- Pick up leaves and trash.

Qualifications:

Responsibilities:

- Proficient in running heavy equipment;
- Experience in operating cranes, clamshells, power shovels, motor graders heavy loaders, carryalls, bulldozers, rollers and scrapers;
- Operating large industrial tractors with pan or scrapper attachments;
- Able to maneuver in tight quarters;
- Placing the equipment in operation.
- Using vehicle controls and emergency equipment;
- Able to read and interpret grad and slope stakes and simple plans;
- Able to grease, adjust and make emergency repairs to equipment;
- Log Book entries to be current containing: date, month year entered for the beginning of each 24 hour period.
- Ability to excavate, load or move dirt/sand, gravel or other materials.

Qualifications:

- Placing the vehicle in operation.
- Using vehicle controls and emergency equipment;
- Turning;
- Braking and slowing by means other than braking
- Backing and parking.
